Betty Petty Week

The Betty Petty Style Trophy is on week beginning Monday, 7th November, starting at 7:00pm.

This competition is open to everyone that is 15 years and under and it is not about speed but a demonstration of your technique and ability.

You will be assessed on Backstroke, Breaststroke and Frontcrawl over two lengths, with starts and turns included.

So it doesn't matter if you are fast or slow, it is the person with the best stroke and technique that wins.

You can enter on-line, fill in a form or just turn up just before 7:00pm at the Pendle Leisure Centre.

The assessment will now be taking place on a Club night, with the session split between Monday and Thursday in Lane 1. You are advised to bring a spare towel or t-shirt for the pool side as there is only one swimmer in the water at any one time. The rest will be on the pool side.

NOTE: The lanes 2 to 6 will still be holding lessons.

Helpers Required

We require some volunteers to help run the Championship Galas.

We require the following:

- 6 Time Keepers - stop watches provided.
- 2/3 Judges - check turns and finishing order.
- 2 Marshals - make sure children swim in correct events.

Without help we will not be able to run these galas.

Rotherham A/B Grade and Teaspoon Galas

On Saturday, 24th September, there were two members of Colne ASC taking part in the **Rotherham Metro ASC A/B Graded September Meet**, held at the Ponds Forge International Sports Centre in Sheffield.

Saskia Daly was competing in the 11 years age group and she finished 9th in the A Grade 200m Freestyle, 1st in the B Grade 50m Butterfly, 4th in the A Grade 50m Freestyle, 7th in the B Grade 50m Breaststroke, 8th in the B Grade 50m Backstroke and 7th in the A Grade 100m Freestyle.

Mia Dodman was competing in the 12 years age group and she finished 4th in the B Grade 200m Freestyle, 4th in the B Grade 50m Butterfly, 3rd in the B Grade 100m Backstroke, 1st in the B Grade 50m Freestyle, 6th in the B Grade 50m Backstroke and 1st in the B Grade 100m Freestyle.

On Sunday, 25th September, Saskia and Mia were joined by two more team mates as they all competed in the **City of Sheffield Teaspoon Gala**. Again this was held at Ponds Forge, but this time it was long course (50m)

Saskia Daly was competing in the 12 years age group (yes she did move up an age group as it was her birthday). She finished 25th in the 50m Butterfly, 22nd in the 50m Freestyle, 38th in the 50m Backstroke and 36th in the 50m Breaststroke.

Mia Dodman was competing in the 12 years age group and she finished 23rd in the 50m Butterfly, 31st in the 50m Freestyle, 33rd in the 50m Backstroke and 39th in the 50m Breaststroke.

Eleanor Fuggle was competing in the 14 years age group and she finished 13th in the 50m Breaststroke, 16th in the 50m Butterfly and 18th in the 50m Freestyle.

Daniel Fuggle was competing in the 12 years age group and he finished 17th in the 50m Freestyle, 15th in the 50m Backstroke and 14th in the 50m Breaststroke.

Friendly League

On Monday, 19th September, a team of Colne ASC swimmers travelled to Todmorden for our penultimate fixture in this seasons North East Lancs Friendly League.

It proved to be comfortable victory for the Colne swimmers as they beat the hosts, 71 points to 49.

During the course of the evening the Colne swimmers managed 18 further new personal bests with 6 for the girls and 12 for the boys.

On Thursday, 29th September, Colne ASC were hosts to Great Harwood Otters in our final league fixture of the season.

The visitors got off to a flying start as they won all of the backstroke races. After that Colne started to close the gap, as both teams traded wins, but in the end the poor start resulted in Colne losing by 4 points as Great Harwood won by 61 points to 57.

During the course of the evening the young Colne swimmers managed a further 38 new personal bests with 23 amongst the girls and 15 for the boys.

North East Region Masters

On Sunday, 25th September, three members of the Colne ASC Masters Team were competing at the Hydro pool in Harrogate in the North East Region ASA Masters Championships. The results used an age adjusted formula to determine the winner in each event.

Tony Catterall competing in the 60 years and over age group finished 9th in the 400m Freestyle (2nd in age group), 17th in the 100m Butterfly (2nd in age group), 9th in the 200m Backstroke (3rd in age group), 17th in the 200m Individual Medley (2nd in age group), 8th in the 100m Backstroke (1st in age group), 18th in the 100m Breaststroke (4th in age group), 11th in the 200m Freestyle (2nd in age group) and 13th in the 100m Individual Medley (1st in age group).

Philip Croxall competing in the 45 to 49 years age group finished 10th in the 400m Freestyle (2nd in age group), 12th in the 200m Individual Medley (2nd in age group), 16th in the 100m Breaststroke (1st in age group) and 11th in the 200m Breaststroke (2nd in age group).

Daniel Dawson competing in the 40 to 44 years age group finished 31st in the 50m Breaststroke (4th in age group), 35th in the 50m Freestyle (6th in age group) and 21st in the 100m Breaststroke (2nd in age group).
